


Even divulga a prévia operacional do 2T19

São Paulo, 12 de julho de 2019 – A Even Construtora e Incorporadora S.A. – EVEN (B3: EVEN3), com atuação em São Paulo, Rio de Janeiro e Rio Grande do Sul e com foco nos empreendimentos residenciais a partir de R\$ 250 mil, anuncia dados preliminares e não auditados de lançamentos, vendas, aquisição de terrenos e entregas relativos ao segundo trimestre de 2019.

Lançamentos¹


No 2º trimestre foi lançado 1 empreendimento que totalizou R\$ 155 milhões (parte Even).


Vendas¹

No 2º trimestre, as vendas líquidas somaram R\$ 492 milhões (parte Even), das quais R\$ 32 milhões referem-se as vendas dos lançamentos do trimestre com VSO de 21%. A velocidade de vendas (VSO) do trimestre foi 20%, atingindo a melhor VSO desde 2013.




Land Bank¹

No 2º trimestre foi adquirido, por meio de permuta, 1 novo terreno em São Paulo, com valor potencial de vendas de R\$ 215 milhões (parte Even). O *land bank* encerrou o 2º trimestre com R\$ 6,9 bilhões em VGV potencial (parte Even).



Entregas¹

No 2º trimestre foram entregues 4 projetos que equivalem a R\$ 314 milhões (VGV de lançamento parte Even) e 706 unidades.




Even discloses preliminary 2Q19 operating result

São Paulo, July 12, 2019 – Even Construtora e Incorporadora S.A. – EVEN (B3: EVEN3), a builder and developer with operations in the states of São Paulo, Rio de Janeiro and Rio Grande do Sul, focused on residential developments with units priced above R\$ 250,000, announces its preliminary and unaudited data for launches, sales, land acquisitions and deliveries in the second quarter of 2019.


Sales¹

Net sales came to R\$ 492 million (Even's share) in the second quarter, R\$ 32 million of which from the project launched in the quarter which SOS was 21%. The sales over supply (SOS) ratio of the quarter was 20%, reaching the best SOS since 2013.




Land Bank¹

In the second quarter we acquired 1 new site in São Paulo, through swap, totaling a potential sales value of R\$ 215 million (Even's share). The land bank ended the quarter with PSV of R\$ 6.9 billion (Even's share).



Deliveries¹

In the second quarter, we delivered 4 projects with launch PSV of R\$ 314 million (Even's share of launched PSV) and 706 units.
